

Bruce J. Hunt is an Associate Professor of History at the University of Texas at Austin. He obtained the B.A. degree in History and B.S. degree in Physics from the University of Washington in 1979 and the Ph.D. degree in History of Science from Johns Hopkins University in 1984. He has taught in the University of Texas History Department since 1985. His research focuses on the development of electrical science and technology in the 19th century, particularly in the British telegraph industry.

His first book, *The Maxwellians*, was published by Cornell University Press in 1991; it appeared in a paperback edition in 1994, and was reissued in 2005. Dr. Hunt published more than a dozen articles on electrical theory and practice in the 19th century, including one with that title for Volume 5 of the *Cambridge History of Science* (Cambridge: Cambridge University Press, 2003). He recently published the book “*Pursuing Power and Light: Technology and Physics from James Watt to Albert Einstein*” in 2010 in the Johns Hopkins University Press series of *Introductory Studies in the History of Science*.
