

Vladimir Okhmatovski received the M.S. degree (with distinction) in radiophysics and the Candidate of Sciences (Ph.D.) degree in antennas and microwave circuits from the Moscow Power Engineering Institute, Moscow, Russia, in 1996 and 1997, respectively.
