

Yuanxun Ethan Wang is an Associate Professor of Electrical Engineering at University of California Los Angeles (UCLA). He received the B.S. degree in Electrical Engineering from University of Science and Technology of China, Hefei, China in 1993, and the M.S. and the Ph.D. degrees in electrical engineering from University of Texas at Austin, in 1996 and 1999. He joined UCLA as an Assistant Professor in 2002. Dr. Wang is a technical consultant of several local microwave and radar companies in California. He is a senior member of IEEE. He has published more than 100 journal and conference papers and graduated 9 Ph.D. students. His research is in the general area of microwave and radar systems with emphasis on antennas and phased arrays, high efficiency power amplifiers and transmitters, and integrated RF front-ends. His researches blend the digital processing technologies and concepts into RF and microwave system design, which often lead to new system architectures and novel antenna and circuit configurations.
